



Viewing an 'On Demand' Tutorial

1. Screen Resolution: 1024 x 768

On Demand tutorials are best viewed at screen resolutions of 1024x768 pixels or higher. To verify or change your current display resolution settings, right-click on the **desktop's background** (not on an icon) and select **Properties**, then click the **Settings** tab.

2. Flash Player Version: 8 or higher

On Demand tutorials are best viewed using Macromedia / Adobe Flash player version 8 or higher. If you experience display anomalies or problems with interaction, be sure to check if there's a newer version of the Flash player available for your web browser. Check <http://www.macromedia.com> or <http://www.adobe.com> for the latest player downloads.

3. IMPORTANT - Security Settings for Flash Player: always allow, or always ask

To click on and follow links which are presented in On Demand tutorials make sure that you don't have restrictions in security settings for your Flash player which would prevent you from doing so. If you notice any problems, such as links not responding when you click it, then you most likely may have your web browser's Flash player currently configured with security restrictions. In order to fix this, visit Macromedia's web page at the link below and change your settings to either 'Always allow' or 'Always ask'.
